



LANGLANDS GOLF CLUB LADIES SECTION DOUBLES AND SINGLES COMPETITION RULES

Handicap allowance

Singles – full handicap

Doubles – half the combined handicap

Challenging –this applies to both doubles and the singles

The challenger (player/s at the top) must offer her opponent 3 dates, one must be a weekend. Dates offered should not be in the same week. The challenger must give her opponent 7 days' notice of the first date offered.

Meeting the deadline for matches to be played

The date matches have to be played will be clearly displayed on the draw sheet.

Matches must be played by the due date. There will be **no exceptions**. Failure to play a match by the due date will result in disqualification.

Matches all square after 18 holes

If a match is all tied at the 18th 5 **extra holes will be played to decide the winner**. If the match is still tied after this, then 1 more hole will be played in a 'sudden death' situation

Temporary Greens

Matches must be played if there are at least 14 greens on. If there are more than 4 greens off, then the match should be re-arranged

Player substitution

If your partner in the doubles competition is injured or ill, then you may find a substitute providing that player has not played in any previous rounds of the doubles competition. This also applies to the singles. If this happens you must inform the Captain.
